

Dear Philadelphia Baptist Church,

In September, we continued our training season with the Awana Ministry Conference on September 7th. This year's theme was One More Child. Two weeks later, I attended the Child Discipleship Forum on September 19th and 20th. The focus was on faith formation and how a child's worldview is formed. Thank you for being part of these meetings, supporting them in person, and keeping them in your prayers.

On September 27th, Hurricane Helene reached Western North Carolina. I know the area was devastated by flooding and destruction. I remembered what Mister Fred Rogers used to say about scary things: "Look for the helpers. You will always find people who are helping."

Jaime Rhinehart is the Awana Ministry Director at Poovey's Chapel Baptist Church. She said, "I think everyone has just been in survival mode for days, and it's hitting home the amount of devastation in our communities! I scheduled Awana tonight so we can create a space for the kids who are feeling this too, and to offer some smiles and hugs. Our church just announced they are hosting a kids camp for a couple of days to help parents in need of childcare since our schools are closed."

Jamie's husband, Michael Rhinehart, sent this text: "I'm Looking forward to tonight! The Brite idea for tonight is 'God Makes a Way When Things Feel Hopeless.' It seems like perfect timing. Even if we only play games, showing the kids hope will be priceless. I'm praying for all of you."

Carrie Knapp at Steadfast Church said, "Thursday, we are having an informal Awana gathering at church so kids can play and parents can talk. Pray that God would help us comfort each other as we begin to heal. Being part of God's family is a good thing right now."

Thank you so much for your partnership in my ministry. Your support, both in prayers and your financial gift of \$150.00 per month, has been a blessing during the training and a lifeline during the difficult times. I am deeply grateful for your commitment. May God continue to bless you as we work to reach more children. Even in the difficult times, your support is a beacon of hope. Thank you.
