
WHO IS LOTTIE MOON? Lottie Moon was appointed a missionary to China July 7, 1873. She was a bold woman of action and radical obedience who shared Christ with the people of China to the end. Lottie died Dec. 24, 1912, leaving a legacy of love and service to her Lord. Her influence led to the establishment of Woman's Missionary Union and inspired other missions pioneers to join her on the field. Her passionate letter-writing led to the offering that bears her name today, Lottie Moon Christmas Offering® for International Missions.

Sugar Cookie Swirls

INGREDIENTS (Makes 2 dozen)

²/₃ C. shortening

²/₃ C. butter

1½ C. sugar

2 eggs, lightly beaten

3½ C. flour

1 tsp. salt

2 tsp. baking powder

2 tsp. vanilla

Red and green paste food coloring (or colors of your choice)

Decorating sprinkles

DIRECTIONS

In a mixing bowl, beat shortening, butter, sugar, and eggs. On low speed, beat in the flour, salt, baking powder, and vanilla until incorporated. Increase speed to medium and beat until well blended.

Divide the dough into three separate bowls. Mix red food coloring into one bowl-you'll need quite a bit to get a deep, rich color. Do the same to another bowl using green. Keep the third bowl plain.

Roll out each color on separate pieces of waxed paper to about %-inch thickness, making them all about the same size. Carefully flip one on top of the other, lining up the edges of the dough as much as possible and removing the waxed paper after flipping. Once stacked, use a <u>pizza cutter</u> to trim the edges straight. Starting at one long side, roll the layers tightly together, lifting up the waxed paper underneath to help roll. Wrap the waxed paper around the roll and chill overnight.

Preheat your oven to 375 degrees. Use a <u>sharp knife</u> to cut dough into %-inch thick slices. Roll the edges in decorating sprinkles and set slices on a parchment paper-lined <u>cookie sheet</u>. Bake about 10 minutes, until just barely done.

Dear Family of God of Philadelphia,

As I am writing this article I am sitting in my office at the church, and I am just overwhelmed by the memories that are in this room. Let me just share a few of the pictures that I am seeing.

- ** To my left is my favorite mission trip picture of all time. It is of a young lady I saw in Cape Town, South Africa. Every Friday she used to come to the city and clip the fingernails of the homeless. I managed to snap a picture of her doing this for one of those unfortunate, priceless souls. I think about her sometimes and wonder if she still has that servant's heart.
- ** To the right of her picture is the picture of a little boy named Franklin that I met in Honduras two decades ago. He was six at the time. Franklin's feet were terribly deformed, and he struggled to walk. Had he been born in the United States, our doctors would have repaired his feet so he could walk normally. But he was not born in the U.S., so he struggles. I have not seen Franklin since I took his picture. But I think of him often, and wonder how his life is today.
- ** Right in front of me is a picture of me skydiving. My jump master on that day was a man named John. We are both smiling in the picture, even though we are 10,000 feet in the air, and falling at 130 mph. John will forever be a part of my life because I put my life in his hands, and he kept me safe. I hope John is still doing what he loves, bringing joy to those like me who lack good sense.
- ** Finally, to my right there is a conglomeration of pictures that have been given to me over the years. Wedding pictures. Sports pictures. Graduation pictures. Family Christmas Cards. Pictures of people who loved me enough at the time to share their lives and their pictures with me.

So, here is the reason for this tour of my office. Over the Christmas holidays, you are going to be surrounded by people who are precious to you at this moment in time. Some of them, you may never see again. Treat your time with them as you would a precious treasure. Look them in the eyes and tell them how much you love them. Thank God for bringing them into your life. Take pictures of them so the memories can live on in your heart when the mind forgets. The PBC family is this kind of treasure for me. I hope you know how much you mean to me, and how grateful I am to God for each of you. Thank you for loving me, helping me and letting me be your pastor. It is a joy to serve our Lord with you. RCA
